AUDITION INFORMATION SHEET

1. Sign up for a slot on the blue sheet outside of K101
2. When you sign up, grab an audition form.
3. Check out the music available on jaguarchoir.com (go to the musical tab at the top of the page)
4. Pick the song you feel most comfortable singing and use the tracks to learn in.
5. See the choir teachers or Mr. Goldwasser for sheet music/lyrics.
6. Be early for your time-slot so you have plenty of time to get a drink, look at your music one last time, and relax.
7. When you arrive, hand the stage manager your completed audition form or get one from the stage manager and fill it out and return it to them as quickly as possible.
8. At your audition time, the stage manager will send you into the room. Introduce yourself and then we'll play the piano track for whichever song you learned and you'll sing your audition.
9. That's it! You're done!
10. On Thursday morning (the 20th), a callback list will be posted outside of room K101 with the names of everyone I'd like to see more of. Those folks will report to K101 at 4PM for callback auditions. Those will be finished by 8PM at the latest.
11. Callbacks will be focused on acting. I will be giving you pieces of the script to read and pairing you off with other actors to read scenes with.
12. On Friday at 3:55 PM, a cast-list will be posted outside of K101.

*Being called back doesn't mean you'll get a part. And not being called back doesn't mean you won't. Really. Please have fun with this. I always like to think of an audition as my own little one-person show. I get to be the star of the show for at least a couple minutes. Put your best foot forward and remember that we're rooting for you. We want you to do great. And we support you. We also know that just being willing to put yourself out there is an accomplishment. So be proud! And thank you for making the effort.
