

Chamber Choir Requirements

1. Students must maintain eligible status all year. We have many performances off campus. Per MISD standards, any student who is ineligible cannot go on field trips.
2. Students must adhere to a high level of personal conduct. Students are expected to behave with respect and courtesy both on campus and off. We are a highly visible group and we represent MISD, Horn HS, and the choir department at all times.
3. Students must have a high level of sight-reading and pitch matching ability. We are an a cappella group and are required to be extremely sensitive musicians. All members must have exceptional tuning and blending vocal technique.

Highlights of the Year Include:

October – singing the National Anthem at the homecoming Pep Rally and Game

November – singing the National Anthem and patriotic songs at the MISD Veteran's Day breakfast

December – caroling at North Park Mall, Children's Medical Center, the Ritz-Carlton hotel, the Dallas Zoo, Berry Middle School, and Terry Middle School

February – singing at the MISD 6th Grade Festival, and at Solo & Ensemble competition

April/May – Chamber Show performance

May – Chamber seniors perform the National Anthem at Baccalaureate
